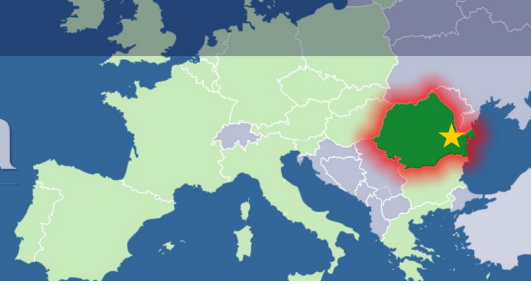

1. We have many things to accomplish in the next ten weeks before we go on state side assignment (May 3rd). Please pray that we will be efficient with our time and that we will get everything accomplished from filing taxes, to securing a vehicle, completing our medicals, homeschooling needs must remain a priority, getting airline tickets, packing up the house, securing appointments in the States, etc. - *Karla*
2. Please pray for our new work in Brailita (North Braila). We have a group that meets on Wednesdays. We have been prayer walking the area and have met several people, please pray for them: George, Laura, Paula, Cristian, Lorenzo, Mariana, and others. Pray that we will meet more and more people and that God will show us favor as we start working towards a church plant there. - *Troy & Randy*
3. Pray for our group as we are presenting the entire Galati plan and work that we do as the "National Bible Reading Campaign" this Sunday night in Braila at the Metanoia church. We are hoping to bring the entire team down there and show how the work we are doing can be used to reach people for Christ and start new groups. We should have around 25 people there of which over half are involved in two church plants as a part of their weekly work for the Lord. Pray that the Lord will show favor on our team as we try to encourage this church in their efforts to start groups that will multiply. - *Troy and our incredible Team of Nationals!*
4. Pray for a man named Bogdon (the one that helped me design the Kingdom Doctrinal Track) who is now wanting to begin attending our groups and study his Bible. He really needs our prayer that this will be a real solution to his problems and not just a "band aid" fix. Pray for Dragos's group as I am trying to get him in this group that meets on Tuesdays. - *Troy*
5. Pray for our team as we begin to train the small group that meets on Wednesdays at Brailita taking them through the Galati Plan. We will take them through what we call the "Gateway" lessons the next few weeks. This is probably the most important thing we are doing right now. Trying to combine our team's work and past experiences with their vision to plant many house churches in Braila. - *Troy & Justin*
6. Pray for Jordan to stay disciplined with prayer and studying the Word. Also, that he would have patience with teaching the guitar with Romanian students that do not speak English. And that he would get over the fever he has right now. - *Justin*
7. Pray that I would work patiently with the youth group that I lead on Saturday nights. This is new to me in leading a bunch of 14 year olds. Also, that I would be able to effectively teach English on Tuesdays. On Friday's I will train those in the youth group that desire to be a leader in their church small groups. And that God would allow me to spend some disciplining time with Cristi and Nicu so that they will be effective in their families and with their friends for the sake of the Gospel. - *Justin*
8. Please pray that as I start using my singing gift in the churches and streets, God will give me power and clarity of mind to present the words of the songs in such a way that the hearts of those who listen will be ready to receive the Gospel message. - *Randy*
9. Pray that as we continue to have encounters with our "block" neighbors, we will have more witnessing opportunities... especially with Adrian and his family and our friend on the 2nd floor.
