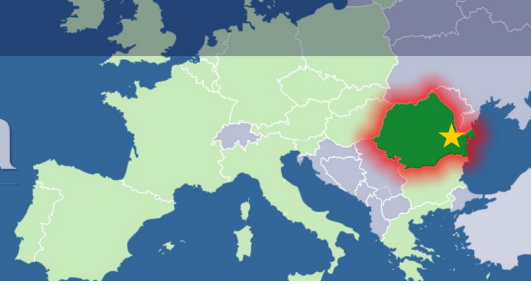


Team Eastern Romania
